

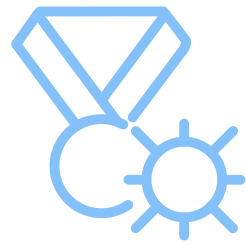

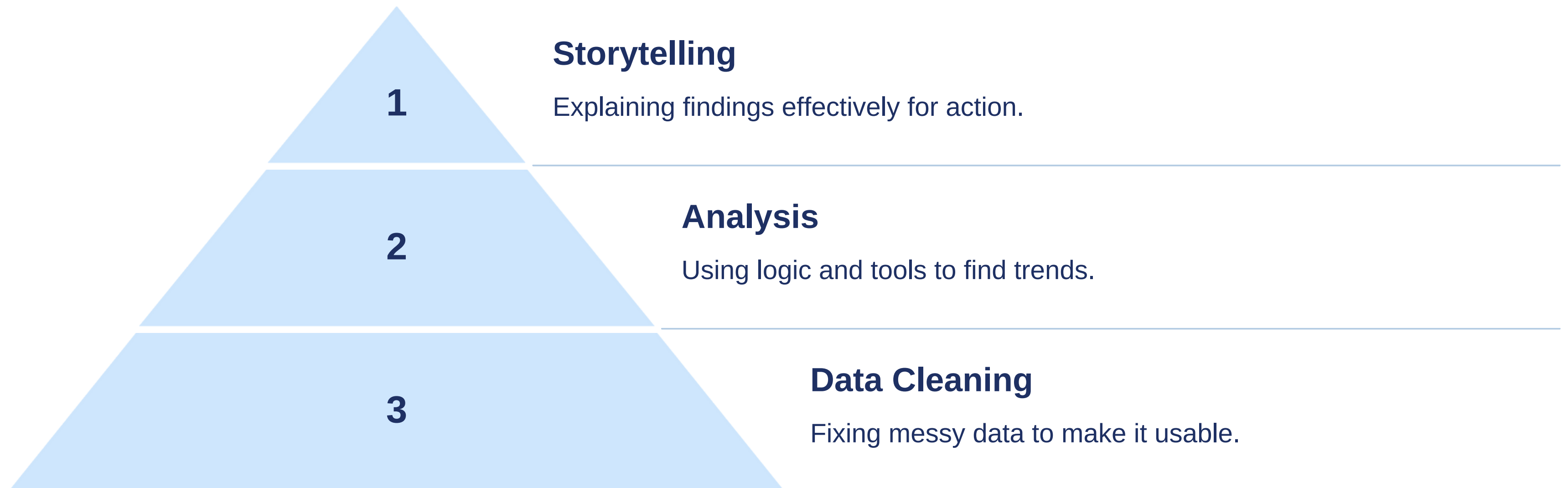

Your foundation for data modeling and basic analysis.



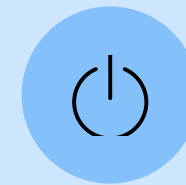
SQL
